Traditional Location

Josephus' claimed that Sinai was the highest mountain in the Sinai Pennisula.

Queen Helena, mother of Constantine the "Great," chose Jebel Musa in the Sinai Peninsula as the site at 7,497 feet

Saint Catherine's Monastery lies on the Sinai Peninsula, at an elevation of 8,625 feet on Mt. Catherine

In the 6th century the monastery was moved to the foot of Mount Catherine, following the guidance of Josephus' claim

Location According to Scripture Galations 4:21-26

Tell me, you who desire to be under the law, do you not hear the law? 22 For it is written that Abraham had two sons: the one by a bondwoman, the other by a freewoman. 23 But he who was of the bondwoman was born according to the flesh, and he of the freewoman through promise, 24 which things are symbolic. For these are the two covenants: the one from Mount Sinai which gives birth to bondage, which is Hagar— 25 for this Hagar is Mount Sinai in Arabia, and corresponds to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children— 26 but the Jerusalem above is free, which is the mother of us all.

Josephus never calls the Sinai Peninsula "Arabia"

The Sinai Peninsula is a peninsula in Egypt

No maps surviving from the first century. Most are 1700s

~ 20 years ago a new site suggested named Jabal al Lawz in Saudi Arabia (Mountain of almonds)





Numbers 33:1-49 Recap of Israel's wanderings

- from Marah and came to Elim
 (twelve springs of water and seventy palm trees)
- from Elim and camped by the Red Sea
- from the Red Sea and camped in the Wilderness of Sin
- from the Wilderness of Sin and camped at Dophkah
- from Dophkah and camped at Alush
- from Alush and camped at Rephidim, where there was no water for the people to drink.
- from Rephidim and camped in the Wilderness of Sinai


Exodus 15.27 and Numbers 33.9 as a place where "there were twelve wells of water and seventy date palms," and that the Israelites "camped there near the waters".



Exodus 17:6, "Behold, I will stand before you there on the rock in Horeb; and you shall strike the rock, and water will come out of it, that the people may drink."




Split Rock at Horeb?

Exodus 19:18, "Now Mount Sinai was completely in smoke, because the Lord descended upon it in fire. . ."





Exodus 24:4 records that Moses "... built an altar at the foot of the mountain, and twelve pillars according to the twelve tribes of Israel."




Foot of mountain, V-shaped altar, each arm approx. 60 feet long & 20 feet wide.





Exodus 32:4, where Aaron "... received the gold from the hand, and he fashioned it with an engraving tool, and made a molded calf."




Golden Calf Altar. 30 feet tall and 30 feet across, etched with ancient drawings of a bull god and a menorah.

1 Kings 19:18b, 13b: "... and he went ... as far as Horeb, the mountain of God and he went out and stood in the entrance of the cave"




