third and fourth generation of those who hate me,
6 but showing love to a thousand generations of
those who love me and keep my commandments.
7 "You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your
God, for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who
misuses his name.



Exodus 20:1-17

8 "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

9 Six days you shall labor and do all your work,

10 but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates. 11 For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

12 "Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you.

13 "You shall not murder.

14 "You shall not commit adultery.

15 "You shall not steal.

16 "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

17 "You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."

1. You are to have NO OTHER GODS BEFORE ME

- You are to love & trust the God of the Bible. Give your heart to the one true God.

2. DON'T HAVE IDOLS

- Don't play games with God. Don't invent a rival god, in your mind or in your back yard.

3. DON'T TAKE GOD'S NAME IN VAIN

- Don't wear His name as a badge, and then drag it through the mud in the way that you speak or the way that you live.

4. KEEP THE SABBATH

- Remember that this world is not your goal or your home, so don't wear yourself out trying to get more of it.

5. HONOR YOUR PARENTS

- They probably gave you a foundation for life, maybe even for eternal life. They are a picture of God's authority.

6. DO NOT KILL

- You are a private individual, so you must seek the safety & welfare of everyone, from the womb to the tomb.

7. DO NOT COMMIT ADULTERY

- Sex is good, safe and right within the context of a one man and one woman marriage.

8. DO NOT STEAL

- Honor the boundaries of property & ownership. Be honest and trustworthy.

9. DO NOT LIE

- Your words should represent the truth. Don't allow your words to damage other people.

10. DO NOT COVET

- Your heart should be content and trusting. To want more & more is greed, and possibly idolatry.
